### OLD BOYS ASSOCIATION ALUMNI RECOGNITION AWARDS

Our graduates are the essence of what our College represents and shining examples of achievement. The inaugural annual CBC Fremantle Old Boys' Association Alumni Recognition Awards aim to showcase the highest accomplishments of our graduates.

Alumni, staff, students and the wider community are all invited to nominate Old Boys of the College who are making a real difference in the world.

One of the most significant elements of CBC Fremantle's vision is to prepare graduates who are distinguished by the values of being CBC gentlemen.

#### Tomorrow's gentleman...

- forms attitudes and actions based on Gospel values
- strives to be his best and understands the inherent value of doing so
- is accountable, resilient and prepared to face and overcome challenges
- is selfless by nature and able to form positive, mutually-beneficial relationships
- recognises and values the 'other' in his life.

Many alumni have embodied this vision within their life of service, their achievements in their chosen field of endeavour or profession, or service to their community or society at a national or international level.

The annual Alumni Recognition Awards recognise the actions and achievements of CBC graduates who have gone above and beyond normal expectations. The awards seek to promote personal excellence and celebrate the diverse achievements of alumni, and provide an opportunity to share these inspirational stories with our community.

### AWARD CATEGORIES

#### Community (open age)

Acknowledges alumni who have demonstrated commitment to service in the community and made a significant positive impact through humanitarian and charitable endeavours.

#### Leadership (30 to 60 years of age at the time of nomination)

Recognises alumni who are making a significant contribution as leaders within their profession and/or within their community and who are likely to be an inspiration to the next generation of graduates.

#### Rising Star (up to 30 years of age at the time of nomination)

Recognises graduates whose early accomplishments have made an exceptional impact in their field of endeavour.

### JUDGING

- Awards are at the discretion of the Principal and the Old Boys' Annual Awards committee. If consensus is not reached, the final decision will be made by the Principal (or his nominee).
- Awards may not be made each year if a suitable candidate is not available.
- The Awards selection panel will review and select the nominees. The awards will be announced at the CBC Old Boys' Reunion on 18 March 2017. Award winners will be notified prior to the Reunion.

### **NOMINEE ELIGIBILITY**

#### **Community**

- Has made significant contributions to the betterment of society through humanitarian and charitable endeavors.
- Is distinguished by the five values of a CBC gentleman.
- Has demonstrated high standards of personal character and integrity.

#### **Leadership**

- Has achieved recognised success in his professional field and/or demonstrated leadership abilities.
- Is distinguished by the five values of a CBC gentleman.
- Has demonstrated high standards of personal character and integrity.

#### **Rising Star**

- Has demonstrated characteristics that indicate future success and significant contributions in their field (professional, community, cultural, sporting or leadership).
- Is distinguished by the five values of a CBC gentleman.
- Has demonstrated high standards of personal character and integrity.

### **NOMINATION CRITERIA**

Nominees must comply with the selection criteria provided under Nominee Eligibility. In 250 words or less, the written statement should briefly address the following:

#### **Community**

1. How has the Nominee contributed to the betterment of the community?
2. In what ways have the Nominee's achievements been extraordinary?
3. How has the Nominee demonstrated high standards of personal character and integrity?

#### **Leadership**

1. How has the Nominee demonstrated leadership in their chosen field of endeavour?
2. How has the Nominee demonstrated outstanding professional and/or community involvement likely to be an inspiration to the next generation?
3. How has the Nominee demonstrated high standards of personal character and integrity?

#### **Rising Star**

1. How has the nominee made a significant impact in their field?
2. How has the nominee performed service which is innovative or beneficial?
3. How has the nominee demonstrated high standards of personal character and integrity?

### NOMINATION PROCESS

- A Nomination Form must be completed.
- Written statement (maximum 250 words) addressing the criteria provided and detailing why the Nominee deserves to be recognised should accompany the Nomination Form. Brief nominations are encouraged.
- Optional supporting evidence such as awards, media clippings, electronic media footage, etc can be included (maximum of 3 attachments).
- Nominees must be informed of their nomination by the Nominator prior to submission.
- The assistance of the Nominee may be sought in compiling the nomination.
- The Nominator's and /or winning Nominee's name, image and statement may be published and/or used in any form of media, in any context relating to the awards.
- Winners and their nominators will be personally contacted prior to the announcement of the Awards.
- Alumni may nominate themselves or be nominated by another person.
- You do not have to be an Old Boy or current community member of the College to make a nomination.
- Current employees of CBC Fremantle who are Old Boys are eligible for nomination.
- Nominees must have attended the College for at least two years.
- An alumnus cannot win more than one award category in any calendar year and cannot win the same award category more than once.
- Awards will not be awarded posthumously.
- Joint nominations will not be accepted.
- The selection panel's decision is final on all matters relating to the nomination process and the selection of winners, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The selection panel reserves the right not to allocate an award in one of the categories if, in their opinion, there are no entries of sufficient merit.
- The number of awards allocated in each category will be at the selection panel's discretion.
