From the Principal

Today's boys... tomorrow's gentlemen

During this week all of our Year 9 students have been enjoying a variety of opportunities outside of the classroom. All of the activities in which they have been engaged have been designed to assist in their growth as young men and to provide a culmination to *The Rite Journey* programme which they have been undertaking this year.

For three of the days the boys have been in Bindoon testing their physical and mental endurance. A combination of trekking through the bush, undertaking challenging tasks and sleeping in unfamiliar surrounds and conditions has ensured that they are well and truly out

of their comfort zones. Very importantly, this activity has been accompanied by many opportunities for guided reflection. The boys have been invited to contemplate their boyhoods to date and to make a number of choices and commitments about the type of young men they want to be in the future.

We are very grateful to our sibling school in Bindoon for generously allowing us to share their property during this week. Catholic Agricultural College has permitted our boys to roam their wonderful bush and farming property and has been hospitable in every sense. The grand buildings, statues, historic cemetery, livestock and thousands of hectares of working farm have certainly

The remaining two days of this week have been split between a *The Rite Journey Challenges* programme and a retreat. I would like to thank all of the staff for their selfless contributions to this week. As I said at our recent Awards Evening, I am sure that all of the parents recognise and appreciate the extra time and effort expended by the staff of this College on behalf of the young men entrusted

to their care. I would like to particularly acknowledge Mr Jason Matthews who has spent the entire week at Bindoon away from his young family and each of our *Rite Journey* teachers for their commitment and personal involvement in conducting the programme at CBC. Their efforts and those of so many others have been critical to ensuring that our Year 9 boys have been provided with this unique experience.
